Lent

Lent is the 40 days prior to Easter (not counting Sundays) where we are asked to think about our lives and how we can turn around and have a more purposeful existence following Jesus.

In the Old Testament, Moses and the people of God wandered in the wilderness waiting for God to show them the land that would be theirs. The people complained over and over about the journey, so poisonous snakes are sent to bite them. They asked God to save them, saying that they were sorry for doubting God. God directs Moses to capture a snake and place it on a pole. When the people are bit by a snake in the future, they will be able to look at the serpent on the pole and be healed.

Jesus was sent into this world to be lifted up and show us God's forgiving Grace and healing of His people.

In these future weeks think on your purpose. Where do you see Jesus in the world? What are the different ways Jesus brings light and love to the world? What does it mean to have a "purpose in life"? In John 3: 1-17, Jesus tells Nicodemus about his purpose, to show the world God loves it so much that God sends God's only child to earth to be close to us and show us we will be with God forever. Human beings all have a purpose or purposes, reasons why we feel we are here on earth. How might we make the world a better place to live?
